

Subject:

Update on BDD Operations for the Month of May 2021

ITEM:

- 1. This memorandum is to update the Buckman Direct Diversion Board (BDDB) on BDD operations during the month of May 2021. The BDD diversions and deliveries have averaged, in Million Gallons Per Day (MGD) as follows:
 - a. Raw water diversions: 9.44 MGD.
 - b. Drinking water deliveries through Booster Station 4A/5A: 8.42 MGD.
 - c. Raw water delivery to Las Campanas at BS2A: 0.59 MGD.
 - d. Onsite treated and non-treated water storage: 0.43 MGD Average.
- 2. The BDD is providing approximately 77% percent of the water supply to the City and County for the month.
- 3. Regional Demand/Drought Summary and Storage-see page 2.
- 4. The BDD year-to-date diversions are depicted below:




Regional Water Overview

Agreement

Item and Issue:

Request for approval of Amendment No. 3 to the Legal Services Agreement in the amount of \$15,000 exclusive of NMGRT for FY2021 legal services with Long, Komer & Associates and subcontractor Egolf, Ferlic, Martinez & Harwood.

Background and Summary:

On March 7, 2019 the Buckman Direct Diversion Board (BDDB) awarded RFP '19/22/P for legal services to Long, Komer & Associates, P.A. to serve as the legal counsel for the BDDB. On June 4, 2020, the BDDB approved Amendment No. 1 to the legal services contract. Amendment No. 1 extended the award for services to June 30, 2021 and increased compensation for the amended term.

On January 7, the BDDB approved Amendment No. 2 to the legal services contract. Amendment No. 2 increased the compensation in the amount of \$20,000 to provide funding for the Waters of the United States (WOTUS) briefing.

This Amendment No. 3 is to increase the compensation for the current term in the amount of \$15,000.00 for the purposes of increased work load with respect to Los Alamos National Laboratory and Rio Grande water quality issues over the past six months; additional tasks with respect to the Minnow Collaborative program concerning the 2021 drought; and tasks concerning the City return pipeline in relation to the BDDB permit and coordination with staff regarding the permit during the first quarter of 2021.

Action Requested

Staff recommends approval of Amendment No. 3 to the Legal Services Agreement with Long, Komer & Associates, P.A. Funding is available within our approved FY2021 operating budget.





BUCKMAN DIRECT DIVERSION BOARD AMENDMENT NO. 3 TO LEGAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH LONG, KOMER & ASSOCIATES, P.A. #19-0246

THIS AMENDMENT NO. 3 ("Amendment") to the Legal Services Agreement dated March 7, 2019, and as subsequently amended ("Agreement"), is made between the Buckman Direct Diversion Board ("BDDB") and Long, Komer & Associates, P.A. ("Contractor"). The effective date of this Amendment shall be the date it is executed by the BDDB.

RECITALS

- A. Under the terms of the Agreement, Contractor has agreed to provide legal services, acting in the capacity of legal counsel for the BDDB.
- B. Pursuant to Article 18 of the Agreement, and for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are acknowledged by the parties, the BDDB and Contractor agree as follows:

1. **COMPENSATION**

Article 3, paragraph A of the Agreement is amended to increase the amount of compensation by a total of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00) plus applicable gross receipts tax, so that Article 3 paragraph A reads in its entirety as follows:

- A. Compensation under this Agreement shall be in an amount not to exceed Five Hundred Forty-Nine Thousand Dollars (\$549,000.00) plus applicable gross receipts tax.
- B. Contractor shall be responsible for payment of gross receipts taxes levied by the State of New Mexico on the sums paid under this Agreement.
- C. Payment shall be made upon receipt and approval by the BDDB of detailed statements containing a report of services completed. Compensation shall be paid only for services performed.

2. TERM AND EFFECTIVE DATE

Article 5 of the Agreement is amended to extend the term to terminate on June 30, 2022.

3. **AGREEMENT IN FULL FORCE.**

Except as specifically provided in this amendment, the Agreement remains, and shall remain in full force and effect, in accordance with its terms.

ITEM:

Request for approval of Amendment No. 3 to the Professional Services Agreement Item 18-1048 with ALS Group USA, Corp for additional laboratory analysis service for FY 22/23 in the amount of \$90,000 plus applicable tax.

BACKGROUND:

In order to evaluate the concentrations of radionuclides at The BDD, at statistically significant levels a substantial number of samples must be collected and analyzed. The cost to perform this level of sampling is estimated to be \$90,000. BDD currently has an existing contract with ALS Group USA Corp, for conducting this type of analyses. This contract was awarded through RFP '18/46/P Laboratory Analytical Testing Services. This Amendment will increase compensation to provide the funding needed to comply with the additional sampling requirement.

THIS AMENDMENT NO. 3 (the "Amendment") to the Services Agreement dated August 2, 2018, (the "Agreement") is made between the Buckman Direct Diversion Board ("BDDB") and ALS Group USA, Corp. ("Contractor"). The effective date of this amendment shall be the date it is executed by the BDDB.

RECITALS

- A. Under the terms of the Agreement, Contractor has agreed to provide laboratory analysis service for the BDD Board as outlined in the agreement.
- B. Pursuant to Article 18 of the agreement. And for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and Sufficiency of which are acknowledged by the parties, the Board and the Contractor agree as follows:

1. **COMPENSATION**

Article 3, paragraph A of the Agreement is amended to increase the amount of compensation by a total of Ninety Six Thousand dollars (\$96,000) plus applicable gross receipts tax, so that Article 3 paragraph A reads in its entirety as follows:

- A. The BDDB shall pay to the Contractor in full payment of services rendered a sum not to exceed Three hundred Forty-Six Thousand dollars (346,000) plus applicable gross receipts tax.
- B. The Contractor shall be responsible for payment of gross receipts taxes levied by the State of New Mexico on the sums paid under this Agreement.

C. Payment shall be made upon receipt and approval by The BDDB of detailed statements containing a report of services completed. Compensation shall be paid only for services actually preformed.

2. TERM AND EFFECTIVE DATE

Article 5 of the agreement is amended to extend the term to terminate on June 30, 2022.

Except as specifically provided in this amendment, the Agreement remains, and shall remain in full force and effect, in accordance with its terms.

("Contractor"). The effective date of this Amendment shall be the date it is executed by the BDDB.

RECITALS

- A. Under the terms of the Agreement, Contractor has agreed to provide physical prevention and protection to persons and property for the BDDB and Buckman Direct Diversion facilities.
- B. Pursuant to Article 18 of the Agreement, and for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are acknowledged by the parties, the BDDB and Contractor agree as follows:

1. **COMPENSATION**

Article 3, paragraph A of the Agreement is amended to increase the amount of compensation by a total of One Hundred Seventy-Nine Thousand Dollars (\$179,000.00) plus applicable gross receipts tax, so that Article 3, paragraph A reads in its entirety as follows:

A. Compensation under this Agreement shall be only for services rendered at an hourly rate of Twenty-Seven Dollars and Twenty-Six Cents (\$27.26) per hour for each Security Officer III, including the vehicle and all equipment for each Security Officer III and an hourly rate of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for emergency call in. The BDDB shall pay to Contractor for services rendered a sum not to exceed Seven Hundred Sixteen Thousand Dollars (\$716,000.00) plus applicable gross

receipts tax. Compensation to be paid for any renewal term shall be agreed upon by the parties.

- B. Contractor shall be responsible for payment of gross receipts taxes levied by the State of New Mexico on the sums paid under this Agreement.
- C. Payment shall be made upon receipt and approval by the BDDB of detailed statements containing a report of services completed. Compensation shall be paid only for services performed.

2. TERM AND EFFECTIVE DATE.

Article 6, of the Agreement is amended to extend the term to terminate on June 30, 2022.

B & D Industries Amendment No. 3

ITEM

Request for approval of Amendment NO. 3 to Service Agreement Item 19-0056 with B& D Industries, Inc. for on-call HVAC repair services for FY2022 in the amount of \$55,000 plus applicable tax.

BACKGROUND

On November 11, 2018 the Buckman Direct Diversion Board approved the request to award RFB '19/05/B On-Call HVAC services to B & D Industries, Inc. This request will extend the award for services to June 30, 2022, which enters into the final term of the contract. This amendment will also increase compensation for the amended term in the amount of 55,000 plus tax.

BDD has many heating ventilation and air conditioning units throughout the facilities. These units provide temperature control for our pumps and equipment. If a unit fails it is extremely important that the unit is repaired in a timely manner so that the pumps and equipment do not overheat. This service will be utilized to supplement the current resources in the repair and maintenance of BDD equipment.
